Examples of services offered by GeoVista are:

- Compilation of information for mineral exploration licenses, new applications as well as extension of existing licenses.
- Filing of license applications with the Inspector of Mines (IOM).
- Compilation of estate maps and stakeholder listing as required by the Minerals Act.
- Keeping track of due dates for exploration licenses.
- Preparation and communication of work plans according to the Minerals Act.
- Communication and coordination with landowners, stakeholders and authorities.
- Applications for drill permits, coordination according to the Environmental Code, Terrain driving permission etc.
- Compilation of conflict maps with regard to nature reserves, Natura-2000 areas, sensitive areas, ancient remains etc.
- Preparation and communication of proposals for landowner reimbursement after completed work programs.
- Reporting of exploration data after relinquishing exploration licenses, as required by the Minerals Act.
